

**More Initiatives for Senate District 8  
Senate Bill 165**

SANTA FE – Senator Pete Campos, D-Las Vegas, today announced that nearly \$167,000 will be directed to area projects from legislation approved by the Senate. The legislation, Senate Bill 165, contains several appropriations that Campos sponsored.

The legislation will go to the House of Representatives, which is expected to add funding for similar projects. As passed by the Senate, the legislation appropriates:

- \* \$55,000 for a staff position at the San Miguel county bureau of elections;
- \* \$25,000 for support staff for the San Miguel county probate judge;
- \* \$25,000 to the commission for the blind to provide rehabilitation training;
- \* \$25,000 for the Memorial Middle School agriculture science center in Las Vegas;
- \* \$30,000 for the East Torrance Soil and Water Conservation District to conduct education and training programs; and
- \* \$6,700 an educational outreach program with New Mexico Highlands University athletics support group.
