- 14 years as a State Senator representing more than 28 incorporated and unincorporated entities

I have maintained a comprehensive and informed approach to all issues affecting New Mexico's well being. Some of my contributions (*always with the help of colleagues and constituents*) to our state and district include, but are not limited to:

- Health Care – Secured construction and program operational funds for rural public health centers, the Estancia Medical Facility and fought to keep Medicaid accessible to those in need.
- Education – Initiated a 1993 full-day kindergarten study and supported funding for full-day kindergarten, teacher and all other school personnel salaries, healthy lifestyles for students, dual language instruction, the Moriarty Municipal School Performing Arts Theater and the funding for Public School Capital Outlay that has tremendously helped school districts upgrade their instructional buildings and infrastructure.
- Senior Citizens – Supported Cost of Living Adjustments (COLA), reduced prescription drug costs, improved and equipped Senior Citizen Centers and many other quality of life issues.
- Economic/Infrastructure Development – Initiated and successfully secured funding for a Warm Water Fish Hatchery, Rearing Station and Educational Center to be located in Santa Rosa; Wagon Mound Water System Improvements; Anton Chico Library; NMHU Science Building; Watrous Community Center; Moriarty Pinto Bean Park Improvements; Mountainair Fire Department Addition; Vaughn City Hall Improvements and Edgewood Wastewater System Improvements.
- Local Governments – Have worked closely with elected and appointed officials to fund projects like courthouse improvements; acequia, domestic, and wastewater project upgrades; and road resurfacing for increased user safety.
- State Government – Have fought to improve the operational budgets for the Las Vegas Medical Center, New Mexico Highlands University, Luna Community College, New Mexico Department of Transportation and all other state agencies within the district.
